The Reverend Walter Plimmer, a former New York actor and leading man in many Broadway productions was ordained priest of the Roman Catholic Church and said the Actors Mass at the Actors Chapel of St. Malachy's Church, 49th Street West of Broadway, at 12:15, Sunday June Seventeenth. The A Cappella Singers from St. Mary's Seminary, Baltimore, will sing at the Mass, under the direction of Mr. Norman Leboeuf.
