

Priest Is Chaplain Of Kentucky Police

The Rev. David Zaumeyer, Assistant Pastor of St. Thomas Church, Fort Thomas, was appointed chaplain for the Kentucky state police yesterday by Guthrie Crowe, State Police Commissioner. The appointment is for one year.

Mr. Crowe, in company of Lt. Roy Osborne and Sgt. Robert Roberts of the state police, came to Newport to swear in the new chaplain.

Father Zaumeyer was recommended for the office by State Sen. Paul Stapleton, Fort Thomas. There is no salary attached to the job, with the exception of an allowance for actual traveling expenses.
