Dear Father:

When I was in the sixth and seventh grade (1959-60-61) in Woodbridge, Virginia, I was an alter boy at Our Lady of Angles Church. During this time, I was seduced and sexually abused by a priest in the parish. Father A'Hern (not sure of the spelling) is the priest in question. Immediately following my last encounter, I went to a retreat where I was hammered by the visiting priest about how everything I did was the most mortal of sins. This was the most mixed of signals. I innocently asked another boy where father was and he said he was transferred to the Boston Area to a boys camp.

This has haunted me and the effect these incidents have had on my life can not be understated. I realize that the jurisdiction of Our Lady of Angles is no longer in Richmond but it was at the time of the incidents. The greatest regret is that I didn't turn in the priest. How many other boys were subjected to these unspeakable acts? Where did father go from Woodbridge?

I'm at a point in my life where there needs to be some conclusion. A reflection of my personal relationships and growths are tied to these events.
