Biographical Note: Father Murphy's ministry was hindered as a result of a long and chronic illness. A tribute paid him in *The Globe* shortly after his death at the still young age of 49 aptly noted: "Every priest tries his best to live up to ... being an 'alter Christus,' 'another Christ.' Father Murphy probably most resembles Jesus the eternal high priest in his frustrations. Jesus was so misunderstood by many of the people he loved so dearly.... So, too, Father Murphy felt the frustration of not being understood."
