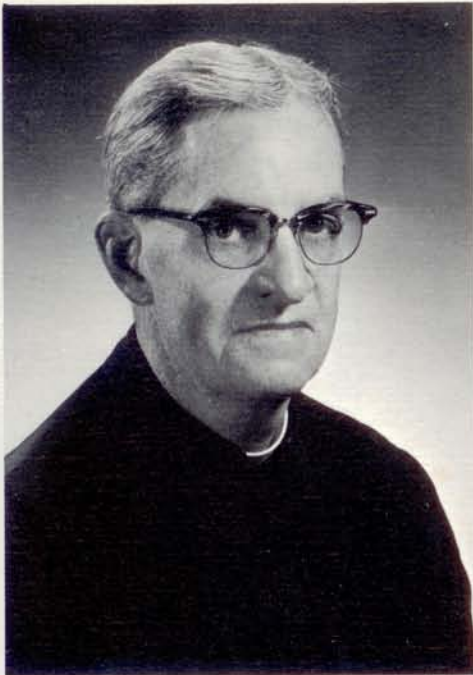

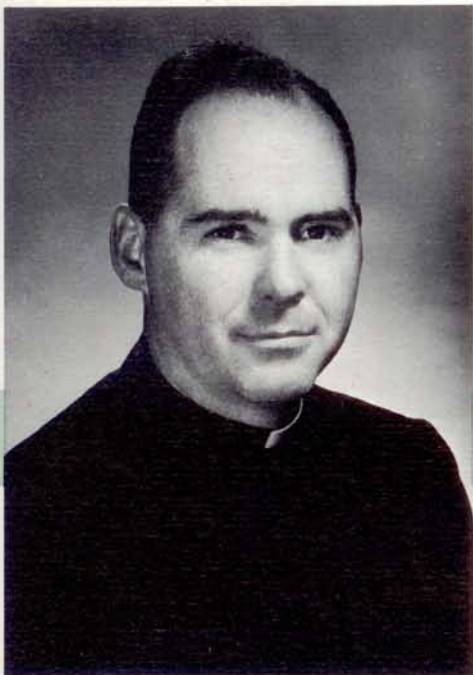

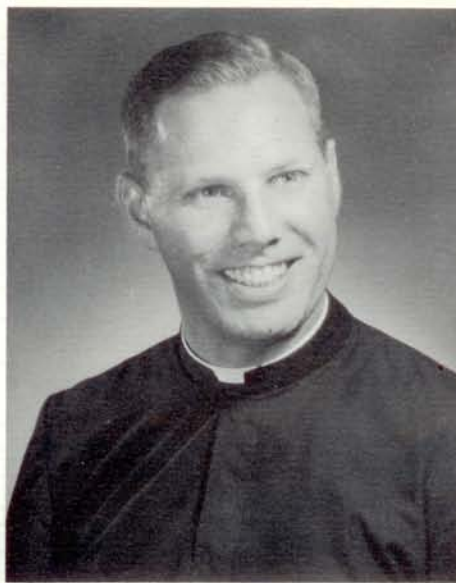


REV. BROTHER CHARLES B. IRWIN

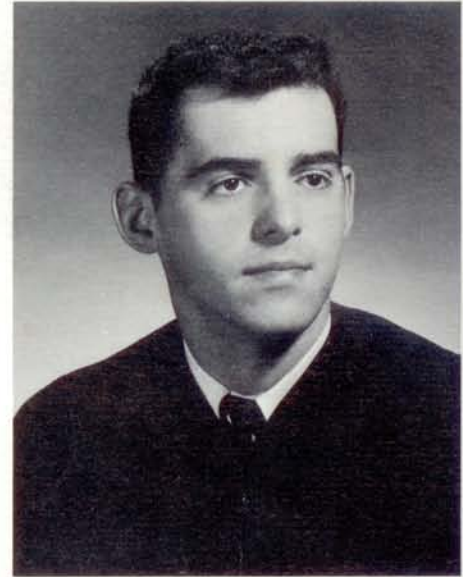
**REV. BRO. RONALD A. HOWE**

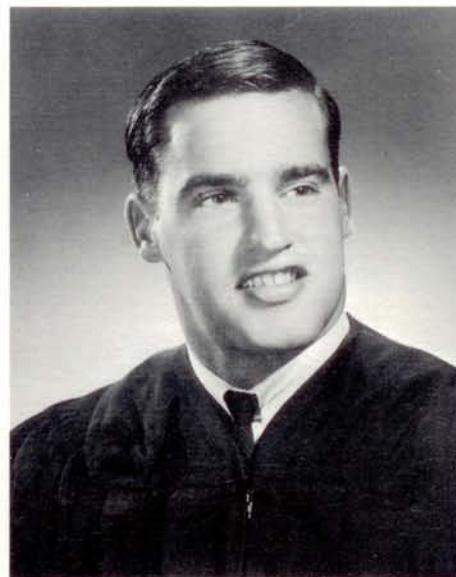
**MR. THOMAS W. IRWIN**

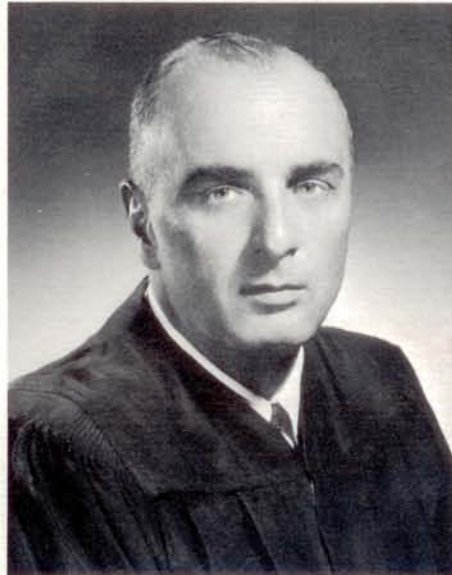
**MR. VICTOR L. LIGGIO**

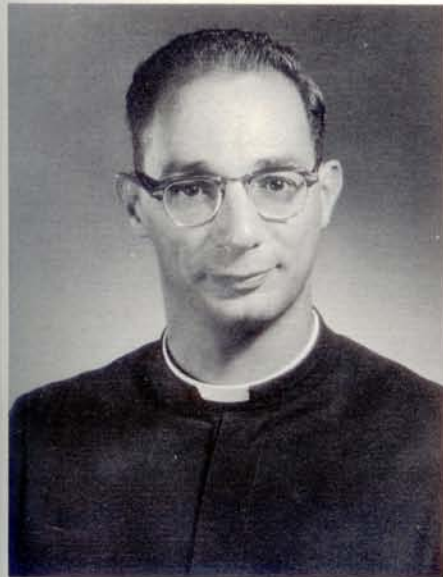


REV. BRO. MICHAEL S.

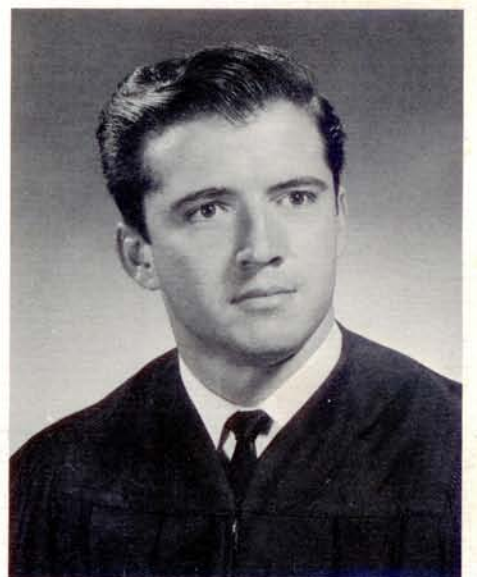
REV. BRO. ANTON J. LIPS
