Your Excellency, Bishop Flanagan:

Permit me to introduce myself before I go on with this lefter. I am Father Benet D. Holley, O.S.B., 34 years of age and ordained a priest for four years. Three years ago, while stationed at Clastonbury Latin School in Hingham, Mass., I first came in contact with Msgr. Joseph P. Burke who is now pastor of St. Patrick's in Lawrence, Mass. Last Christmas, while visiting my sister in Medway, I stopped to see Msgr. Burke and it is he who suggested that I write to you personally.

After frequent prayer to the Holy Ghost and advice from my spiritual director, it is my sincere desire to leave the religious life to become a diocesan priest. During the post three years, I have become increasingly aware that this is my place in God's vineyard. Your diocese, Blshop Flanagan, is where I would hope to achieve personal sanctification while serving God more effectively.

I have applied to no other diocese for admission so I cornestly desire to be in addinated in Wordester. In your diocese I know that I would be happy and do good work so I pray that you may find room for me. As I hoted before, my married sister lives in Medway not too far from the diocesan boundary.

Several priests in the past few years have left our Abbey and become secularized. This has made the Abbot quite angry and is the reason why I hesitated to write sooner. If the Abbot learns of my intention to secularize, it is possible that he may send me to one of the Latin American missions as he has done to the other priests before they were released.
