Father Meffan has refused to go into residential treatment at St. Luke's. However, I think he might be open to outpatient treatment. What would you think of putting him in outpatient treatment and asking him to consider prison ministry? Hospital ministry?

My control concern about putting him back into ministry is that up to this point he has never fully denied the allegations nor does he fully admit them. I wonder if through outpatient treatment he might be helped to come to own the allegations and take advantage of therapy.

We can talk about this on Thursday.

His assignment is to be ended but the letter should not be sent without reflecting the lack of a resolve. Would you share with me the draft letter you have arranged?
