W-001 - This is the man in Boston who sends out emails to the entire world about the terrible things Fr. Carley did to him. We have heard nothing from his quasi attorney (sister-in-law) for a number of months. We have also heard nothing from W-001. All is quiet. (Now that I have written this, I am sure we will find something in the mail soon!)

The [redacted] case - This is [redacted] for whom we paid the costs at Seabrook House in New Jersey for alcohol rehabilitation and then Tucson. [redacted] has not followed up on anything he is supposed to do. He has been in a continuous drunken stupor for the last couple of weeks. I had a successful meeting with Msgr. Lemon in which I was able to share with him a 2½ page summary of the case which was prepared by Beth Krieger. I think Monsignor and I are on the same page with regard to the Diocese having done its duty and more so. My concern now is that the family has "hooked into" Beth Krieger and she is deeply involved not only with [redacted] but also with the family. [redacted] non-responsiveness to his family and his non-cooperation, coupled with our worry of his possibly doing injury to himself, has motivated Beth's continued involvement.

This case is not ours, but rather the Diocese in Louisiana. Tony has so communicated that to both attorney and client.

We discussed the investigation of [REDACTED] in Dover and how the investigators would like to speak to kids at Holy Cross. While the Air Force so indicated the desire to speak with these kids, there has been no follow up. [REDACTED]
